Pupil achievement: performance on standardized tests, score on Academic Performance Index, share of pupils that are college and career ready, share of English learners that become English proficient, English learner reclassification rate, share of pupils that pass Advanced Placement exams with 3 or higher, share of pupils determined prepared for college by the Early Assessment Program. (Priority 4)

Other pupil outcomes: pupil outcomes in the subject areas described in Education Code section 51210 and subdivisions (a) to (i), inclusive, of Education Code section 51220, as applicable. (Priority 8)

Involvement Process Throughout the 2014-2015 year, CAL's primary focus was four-fold: 1. To identify key 'participatory stakeholders' who would commit time and service to help us achieve our LCAP goals. 2. To educate and successfully begin the transition to commit core curriculum benchmarks and standards. 3. To monitor, review, and evaluate our stakeholder participation and progress towards meeting our goals. Impact on LCAP Building a culture of total student-staff and parent involvement became a top priority for the Center for Advanced Learning (CAL). To specifically achieve this objective, the following actions/services were recommended by the LCAP steering team: • Stronger communication with parents through

Throughout the entire year extensive professional development training was provided, and collaborative principal/teacher briefings were conducted to monitor review and evaluate faculty mastering of common core central concepts and how they should be applied.

CAL used the following quantitative data to structure the goal setting process:

- 1. Attendance rates
- 2. Student programs
- 3. Instructional materials
- 4. Facility Inspection Data
- 5. CCSS/SBAC-ELA proficiency rate
- 6. CCSS/SBAC math proficiency rate
- 7. English Learner reclassification rate
- 8. LAUSD site review data

After full compilation and through calculation of all relevant quantitative areas of interest, the CAL LCAP team was able to identify key areas of strengths, weaknesses, and areas where new goals needed to be set.

c. Stakeholders #3—Parents

Parent participation was organized and recorded by monthly logs that were collected at monthly meetings. Monthly parent academic initiative meetings were held and data was collected as to the number of parents attending per month. Parents were informed regarding the goals set for the students via monthly 'coffee with the principal' meetings and an annual survey.

As part of the outreach strategy an online survey was developed which attempted to capture and assess the degree of interest and parental involvement in the CAL learning process. This information was also used to determine from a parental perspective if we needed to change our goals to meet parental expectations.

d. Stakeholders #4—The Community

The CAL LCAP community made concerted efforts to consult with a variety of community organizations. Most notable among that group has been the involvement of the Los Angeles Police Department—

known to our staff and school.

As a result of the collaborative process of gathering input from our stakeholders, CAL developed a "New List" of Goals and Priorities that has captured our focus and require immediate attention: New concerns could include:

- Expansion and development of a middle school.
- Insight about available resources in the community.
- Exploring new ways to expand student aspirations.

Newton St. Division. The police have attended school meetings and spoken with and engaged in discussions with the parents of our students and with staff as well.

The CAL LCAP committee collaborated and synthesized the opinions and input of the above mentioned stakeholders and was able to draw new conclusions about our future years goals and priorities.

Annual Update:

As a result of the collaborative process of gathering input from our stakeholders, CAL developed a new list of goals and priorities that has captured our focus and require immediate attention. New concerns could include. New concerns could include:

- · Expansion and development of a middle school
- Insight about available resources in the community
- Exploring new ways to expand student aspirations for higher achievement
- Opportunities for businesses to help support school activities
- Increasing the opportunities for using technology for learning common core concepts both at school and at home as well

The data obtained from the parent survey proved to be inconclusive. The sample obtained was not large enough to extract meaningful data. Future surveys will require greater promotion and advertising to parents to boost their participation and obtain viable data.

Annual Update:

The actions/services implemented in 2014 appear to have had a positive but incomplete effect on CAL's overall progress. A site audit was conducted by Los Angeles Unified School District (authorizer) revealed new areas for improvement; as a result, these new areas have been targeted as our new goals.

Quantitative and qualitative data was examined which indicated that there is still much progress that must be made in the following areas:

- Language Arts
- Math
- Closing the Achievement Gap
- Special Education

The differences between budgeted expenditures and actual annual expenditures were noted and adjustments will be made for the coming years.

Many of the budgeted expenditures may be adjusted downward due to the inexperience of making projections. Technology costs however soared upward and exceeded budgeted projections. This too was due to the inexperience of estimating what the total coasts would be.

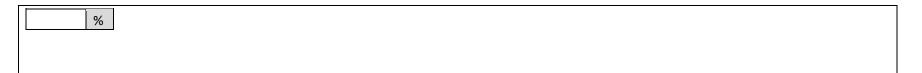

 - (1) The number of cohort members who earned a regular high school diploma [or earned an adult education high school diploma or passed the California High School Proficiency Exam] by the end of year 4 in the cohort where "cohort" is defined as the number of first-time grade 9 pupils in year 1 (starting cohort) plus pupils who transfer in, minus pupils who transfer out, emigrate, or die during school years 1, 2, 3, and 4.
 - (2) The total number of cohort members.
 - (3) Divide (1) by (2).
- (e) "Suspension rate" shall be calculated as follows:
 - (1) The unduplicated count of pupils involved in one or more incidents for which the pupil was suspended during the academic year (July 1 June 30).
 - (2) The unduplicated count of pupils with a primary, secondary, or short-term enrollment during the academic year (July 1 June 30).
 - (3) Divide (1) by (2).
- (f) "Expulsion rate" shall be calculated as follows:
 - (1) The unduplicated count of pupils involved in one or more incidents for which the pupil was expelled during the academic year (July 1 June 30).
 - (2) The unduplicated count of pupils with a primary, secondary, or short-term enrollment during the academic year (July 1 June 30).
 - (3) Divide (1) by (2).
